**Feast Days this week: Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> November – The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica:** The Church of St John on the Lateran in Rome is 'Mother and head of all the Churches of the City of the World.' It is the cathedral church of the Bishop of Rome, and called 'St John' after the two monasteries once attached, dedicated to St John Divine and St John the Baptist. It is however dedicated to the Most Holy Saviour.

**Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> November – St Leo the Great:** died 461, taught the two natures, human and divine, of Christ at the council of Chalcedon 451, and the primary of the See of Peter.

**Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> November – St Martin of Tours:** 335-97, Bishop of Tours, apostle of rural Gaul, founder of monasteries. Patron of France, soldiers, beggars and inn-keepers.

**Friday 12<sup>th</sup> November – St Josaphat:** 1580-1623, Bishop of Polotz, worked for the reunion of the Ukrainian Catholics; his murder by those who opposed it brought about many conversions.
